















AdaHack







- In honour of this day, Hoppers hosts a 12-hour beginner friendly **hackathon** that caters to gender minorities to encourage **diversity in tech**.
- We strive to create a safe and welcoming environment that fosters **collaboration** and **creativity** for everyone.
- Last year we had **over 100** participants with **over 60% being a gender minority** in computer science (however, all are welcome to participate). The event included a **cloud computing workshop** hosted by BlackRock, among other exciting activities.

International women's day

- To celebrate **international women's day**, Hoppers hosted a day-long **conference encouraging diversity and inclusivity** with key highlights being our industry partners' influential involvement.
